



Staff, Freelance and Crew Member Questionnaire

Have you or anyone in your family been in contact with a person that has tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 14 days?

Have you been directed to self-quarantine due to possible exposure to COVID-19?

Have you traveled to any of the “hot spot” states in the past 14 days?
(Alabama, Arizona, Arkansas, California, Florida, Georgia, Idaho, Louisiana, Mississippi, Nevada, North Carolina, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, Utah)

Are you having trouble breathing or have you had flu-like symptoms within the past 48 hours, including: fever, cough, or shortness of breath?

If you answer "yes" to any of these questions you cannot be permitted in our facility or to work on this project. Please contact a Clark Media staff member to report any issues that would prevent you from working.

A temperature check will be taken on location at the start of each production day by the crew chief. If the reading is 100.4° F or higher, you will be directed to go home and contact a medical provider for further guidance.

You are required to follow all CDC guidelines (masks, social distancing, frequent hand washing) to be part of the production crew.

Please arrange your own transportation to and from the set.

If you start to feel flu-like symptoms within 14 days of working on a production with Clark Media please notify us immediately.
